- 11 strengthened with all might, according to His glorious power, for all patience and longsuffering with joy;
- 12 giving thanks to the Father who has qualified us to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in the light.
- 13 He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love,
- 14 in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins.
