Knowing and Loving

Read Psalm 139:1-12

"O LORD, you have searched me and known me."-Psalm 139:1 (NRSV)

In a documentary film about an international celebrity, the film's producer explained how he had come to care deeply about the person who was the focus of this work. "To know anyone is to love them," he said. Though I'm not sure this is true, I thought of the people dearest to me and realized that my knowledge of them is the basis of my love for them. Then I remembered people I had found irritating at first who became more likable to me when I knew their stories. I recalled reading about violent criminals, disgraced public figures, and everyday men and women who became caught in their own weaknesses. All had complex stories; but as I learned their individual histories, my anger and judgment softened.

Soon I realized that God's love for me is rooted in a surpassing depth of knowledge about me. God knows my every fault and virtue. God reads the notes of encouragement I write to others, hears the phone calls I make to a lonely shut-in, and sees me help my disabled son make his bed. God also sees me lose patience, hears the hurtful words I say, and knows every foolish choice I have ever made.

In our weaknesses and our strengths, we can trust that God's intimate knowledge of us is inseparable from God's enduring love for us.
