Becoming a "new creature" is not something that can be brought about by any human effort—whether circumcision or anything else. Jesus refers to this process as the "new birth" (John 3:5-8). It is the divine act in which God takes a person who is spiritually dead and breathes spiritual life into him. This is yet another metaphor to describe the saving act that Paul typically describes as justification by faith.
