Our Father

Read Luke 11:2-4

"Our Father which art in heaven, allowed be thy name." - Luke 11:2 (KJV)

I have clear memories of my beloved grandmother. She came to my room each evening when I was tucked in bed to be sure I said the Lord's Prayer. I often said, "My Father in heaven." Grandma Sophie would smile and gently correct me, saying, "Our Father in heaven." But I felt that God was my Father, mine alone. When I reflect on my simple childhood error, I see a powerful truth. God is "Our Father" in heaven: my God, Grandma Sophie's God, and the God of the entire world. We live in a community of faith. Like brothers and sisters, we share one faith. God's love binds us to God in Christ and to one another. God is truly "Our Father" who gathers all of us into one family, united by God's love. I rejoice in that. Each day when I read The Upper Room, I am reminded of our Father in heaven and our worldwide family. I know that we read each day's devotion and prayer together. God has adopted each of us into the family through Jesus Christ, the Son.
