Sabbath School Memory Text: *“If you believed Moses, you would believe me, for he wrote about me’” (John 5:46, NRSV).*

Key thought: *Like every loyal Jew in the first century, Jesus was subject to the Mosaic law. Raised in a home with loyal Jewish parents, He fully appreciated His rich earthly heritage, which was rooted in Divine providence. He knew that God Himself had inspired Moses to pen these laws, with the purpose of creating a society that reflected His will and served as a beacon to the nations.
